Sub: Extension of approval for admitting students to Foreign Nationals / PIO / Children of Indian Workers in the Gulf Countries, under 15% supernumerary quota for the academic year 2008-09 - reg.

Sir,

Pursuant of the Resolution No.21-2/2003-TS-III dated June 1, 2004, issued by Ministry of HRD, Department of Higher Education, Government of India and the AICTE Regulation No.37-3/Legal/2004 dated 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2004 published in the Gazette of India Extraordinary (Part-III Sec.4) on 30<sup>th</sup> February, 2004, AICTE has decided to grant permission to CENTRE FOR DEVELOPMENT OF ADVANCED COMPUTING, CENTRE OF INDIA ANUSANDHAN BHAVAN, C-56/1, SECTOR-62, NOIDA-201 301 for admitting the students under above categories only for the following courses within 15% of supernumerary seats for the academic year 2008-09 :

Sl. No.	Programme
1.	PG-COMPUTER SCIENCE & ENGINEERING
2.	PG-INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY
3.	PG-VLSI DESIGN

Kindly note, the Institution(s) is entitled to admit the students under the above category and any other category / quota including the students that may have been nominated by various government agencies as per the notification of MHRD, Government of India issued from time to time, provided all such admissions are adjusted with the maximum ceiling of 15% supernumerary seats.

The institutions are required to ensure furnishing the complete list of students admitted latest by 30<sup>th</sup> September 2006, indicating the details of background of the students, the passport particulars, the fee being charged, their residential address, the country of origin, visa documents and such other documents as may be necessary to :

- I. MHRD
- II. AICTE
- III. Ministry of External Affairs (students cell)
- IV. Secretary Education / DTE in the respective State / UT.
- V. The University concerned.

It shall be incumbent upon the Institution concerned to ensure the bonafide of the students, their background and track records, ensuring the interest of the country and its security concerns. While the documents shall be submitted to AICTE merely for the purpose of information, it shall be responsibility of the concerned State Government to ensure maximum regulation of Home Ministry and MEA, as may be applicable.

The AICTE's Gazette Notification vide No.37-3/Legal/Min dated 21-1-2004 (copy enclosed) may be referred for the purpose of admission for this under this category.

The AICTE's Gazette Notification vide No.F 37-3/UGal/2(K4) dated 21/01/2004 may be referred for the purpose of admission, fee etc., under this category.

The State Government may accordingly issue necessary instructions to the institution(s) and the agency concerned.

It may be noted that permission for admission under the PIO category is being granted for the year 2008-09 only, the institution will have to submit a Compliance Report as per format available in the AICTE website for renewal of permission of admitting students under the said category beyond the session 2008-09 (Reference Approval Process, December 2006).
