Eligibility Criteria:

1. The bidder should be either the publisher of the books covered by the Schedule of Requirements given in this document or a distributor authorized by the Publisher for sale of the books covered by Schedule of Requirements.
2. The bidder should have office located in Hyderabad with staff capable of attending any after sales related issues and coordinate with Publisher for rectification of the same.
3. The bidder must not be blacklisted by C-DAC or any other Educational / R&D / Govt. Organizations as on date of submission of the bids. A certificate or undertaking to this effect must be submitted.

Delivery:

1. Delivery of the goods is at the Hyderabad Centre within 2 Weeks after the purchase order is placed with all the necessary documents. Penalty will be charged for delayed delivery of the materials @ 0.5 % of the total cost per week

Validity:

1. Offer terms and conditions should be clearly mentioned; taxes if any should be exclusive. Bids should be valid for 60 days.
2. Prices/Discounts offered cannot be changed under any circumstances, it is therefore suggested that the distributor/reseller shall confirm the price with publisher before submission of the quotation.
3. Information regarding Books which are out of print/ which are under re-print process should be clearly mentioned to avoid delay in delivery of the material.

Payment:

1. 100% payment will be released within 4 weeks from date of delivery of the material along with required documents.

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2. The payment will be initiated only after successful delivery and certified by us upon receipt of Original Invoice with detailed description and certified by concerned CDAC, member

Award of Contract

1. C-DAC shall award the contract to the eligible bidder whose bid has been accepted and determined as the lowest evaluated commercial bid based on the Grand Total calculated of all items + taxes etc. of the Commercial Bids. However, C-DAC reserves the right and has sole discretion to reject the lowest evaluated bid.
2. If more than one bidder happens to quote the same lowest price, C-DAC reserves the right to decide the criteria and further process for awarding the contract, decision of C-DAC shall be final for awarding the contract.

Purchaser's Right to amend / cancel

1. C-DAC reserves the right to amend the eligibility criteria, commercial terms & conditions, Scope of Supply, technical specifications etc.
2. C-DAC reserves the right to cancel the entire tender without assigning any reasons thereof.

Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices

1. It is expected that the bidders who wish to bid for this tender have highest standards of ethics.
2. C-DAC will reject bid if it determines that the bidder recommended for award has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices while competing for this contract;
3. C-DAC may declare a vendor ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated duration, to be awarded a contract if it at any time determines that the vendor has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices during the award / execution of contract.

1. In case of any ambiguity/ dispute in the interpretation of any of the clauses in this Tender Document, the interpretation of the clauses by Director General, C-DAC shall be final and binding on all parties.

- b. Authorization letter issued by the competent authority of bidder authorising the signatory to sign on behalf of the bidder.
- c. A copy of Certificate of Incorporation, Partnership Deed / Memorandum and Articles of Association / any other equivalent document showing date and place of incorporation, as applicable
- d. Other documents necessary in support of eligibility criteria, product catalogues, brochures etc. Note: C-DAC reserves the right to reject the bid if any of the above listed document/s is not submitted.
- e. The Commercial Bid completed in all respects with proper seal and signature of authorised person with name, designation and contact no

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Instruction for Online Bid Submission:

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal. More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.

REGISTRATION:

- Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) by clicking on the link 'Click here to Enrol'. Enrolment on the CPP Portal is free of charge.
- As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India with their profile.
- Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSCs to others, which may lead to misuse.
- Bidder then logs into the site through the secured login by entering their userID / password and the password of the DSC / eToken.

SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS:

- There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, organization name, location, date, value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as organization name, form of contract, location, date, other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / E-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.

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- The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk. PREPARATION OF BIDS:
- Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.
 - Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents – including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100dpi with black and white option.
- To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use 'My Space' area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the 'My Space' area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS:

- Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that he/she upload the bid in time i.e. on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- Bidder has to select the payment option as 'offline' to pay the tender fee / EMD as applicable and enter details of the instrument(s).
- Financial bids to be submitted in PDF format.
- The server time (which is displayed on the bidders' dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission,
- All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the

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secured Socket Layer 128 bid encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done.

- The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.
- Upon the successful and timely submission of bids, the portal will give a successful bid submission message and a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.

ASSISTANCE TO BIDDERS:

- Any queries relating to the tender document and the terms and conditions contained therein should be addressed to the Tender Inviting Authority for a tender or the relevant contact person indicated in the Tender.
